FREDERICTON, Feb. 27- The problem of determining the final disposition of New Brunswick's share of the canteen funds, amounting to \$82,931.25, in the best interests of the returned men of the province is no small task, according to Major J. S. Scott, one of the trustees of the fund. In rebroadcast by the board of trustees for suggestions from returned men there have already been received 129 individual replied.
