The Accused, No. B-83098, Sapper J.F. Fell, No.1 Canadian Tunnelling Company, R.C.E., a soldier of the Canadian Active Service Force, is charged with:

FIRST CHARGE: While on active service in the field stealing public property, in that he, at MICKLEHAM HALL, SURREY, on 6 Dec 40 did steal petrol, the property of No.1 Canadian Tunnelling Coy., R.C.E.

SECOND CHARGE: While on active service in the field committing a civil offence, that is, horsebreaking, with intent to commit a felony contrary to Section 27(2) of the Larceny Act, 1916, in that he at MICKLEHAM HALL, SURREY, on 6 Dec 40, did break and enter the petrol store-house of No.1 Canadian Tunnelling Coy., R.C.E. with intent to commit a felony therein.
