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Q.328 When did you ask De Bartok to reserve these rooms?
A.328 On Monday morning when he approached me to to to Gronigen with the presents.

The witness is questioned by the Judge Advocate:

Q.328 Did you go to Gronigen that weekend?
A.328 Yes, I did.

Q.329 When did you leave?
A.329 On Saturday afternoon, the second of March.

Q.330 You were feeling better?
A.330 Yes sir.

Q.331 What was the number of your jeep - the one you referred to just now?
A.331 The number? - CM.4283684.

The witness is questioned by the Court:

Q.332 Did the doctor actually say it was a slight case of flue that you had?
A.332 I believe those were his exact words - a slight case of flu.

Q.333 And then did he say to you that you should remain in bed for the remainder of the week, even if you might be better Wednesday?
A.333 Yes sir. In fact he ordered me to stay in bed.

Q.334 Did he come to see you during that time?
A.334 Yes sir.

The witness is questioned by the Judge Advocate:

Q.335 When did Corporal De Bartok and Tengum leave for Gronigen?
A.335 That I don't know.

Q.336 Who would be the normal officer to sign their Work Ticket if you didn't sign it? You remember that week because you were sick in bed. Who would have your powers?
A.336 The week that I was sick; Mister Wagner, who was the senior subaltern, used to take over my job when I was away.

Q.337 Now that week, you were 2IC of the squadron?
A.337 Yes sir.

Q.338 The question has been asked to you whether the CO of the squadron was there. Wouldn't you recall whether your CO was there or not during that week?
A.338 I don't recall whether he was there that week or not.

Q.339 Don't you think it in the interest of your squadron that when you were sick that somebody be responsible?
A.339 Major Bult-Frances, the squadron commander spent very little time with the squadron.

Q.340 Can you tell us if Major Bult-Frances visited you in your room when you were sick?
A.340 Yes, Major Frances, did.

Q.341 What day?
A.341 If I remember correctly, Major Frances used to come in to see me about every day.

Q.342 He was there often?
A.342 He was with the regiment, yes.

Q.343 He was with the regiment the whole week?
A.343 Yes.

Q.344 Major Bult-Frances was your squadron commander?
A.344 Yes sir.
