St. Stephen, N. B., Feb. 15.—The annual meeting of the board of directors of the Chipman Memorial Hospital was held today. The officers of last year, J. E. Ganons, president; F. M. Murchie and J. W. Graham, vice-presidents, and J. Vroom, secretary and treasurer, were re-elected. The board consists of Col. Chipman and Lady Tilley, life members of St. Stephen and Miltown, and ton other members, who hold office for five years. Mr. Murchie and Mr. A. Latilin, the retiring members, were reappointed. The treasurer's report showed a balance of \$1,064.10 on hand at the close of the year. The money received and disbursed duting the year was about \$13,000; the number of admissions was 471. The kitchen and the nursee's dining room have been enlarged during the year and some improvements made in the heating arrangements, and a new sterilizer has been installed at a rocost of about a thousand dollars. More room is needed for private patients and the matter of providing additional room, either by another storey or by a new wing was referred to the executive committee.
