It is admitted by some operators that "low production cost mines" might cause a decrease of their product at a lower price than this and still make a fair profit. Some of the mines in Pennsylvania it was pointed out are now selling coal on contract for as low as \$3.75 a ton. But these mines it was contended are the exception and not the rule. The mines where an "ar-

The prices of \$7.75 a ton and \$10 a ton are considerably lower than now being generally paid on the market it was said. The contention was that the abnormal demand for bituminous coal has produced a situation making it possible to include some artificial additions to the price. The

additions may later be wiped out with the increased production and a complete supply but the wiping out process probably will not go lower than the prices quoted.

Hard Coal Higher.

In so far as anthracite coal is concerned, there is a frank suspicion here that the consumers are to face another

boost in the near future. This is admitted to be purely speculative, but the reason given for it by some of those in touch with the coal situation have been made clear.

They state that the "anthracite

production of the past and the present has been controlled by the railroad operating in the anthracite fields. According to some persons the railroad to prevent independent operations

the anthracite fields, have kept the prices at the mines at practically the same level. The production cost thus making no profit. But the railroads, then, it is charged, made up for this action by adding a fine freight rate profit and the consumer paid the bill for the anthracite.

Recently it was pointed out that the railroads have prepared to disassociate their coal properties from their railroad properties. It is assumed here that the disassociation will

genuine in every respect and that the independent anthracite producers will then get into the field. If such is the case, it was said the present anthracite companies can be expected to add on to the present price a profit at

mine. That the present price, ranging around \$15 a ton will then be boosted to something like \$16 a ton is the expectation.

To show how these prices compare

with the pre-war figures, coal authorities here insist that prior to the war a price of \$1.35 for bituminous coal at the mines was welcomed by the operators and that when the price reached \$1.75 at the mine during the war
