WHERFAS We did by certain Letters Patent under Preamble. the Great Seal of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, bearing date at Westminster, the Nineteenth day of July, One Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty Eight, in the Twelfth Year of Our Reign, constitute and appoint Our trusty and well-beloved Sir JOHN GASPARD LE MARCHANT, Knight, then Lieutenant-Colonel and now Colonel in our army, to be Governor and Commander in Chief in and over the Island of Newfoundland, and the Islands and Territories within the limits as therein described, as by the said recited Letters Patent, relation being thereunto had, may more fully and at large appear.

Now Know You that We have revoked and deter-Letters Patent mined, and by these Presents do revoke and determine, of 19th July, the said recited Letters Patent, and every clause, article and thing therein contained.

AND FURTHER KNOW You, that We, reposing especial Ker Baillie trust and confidence in the prudence, courage and loyalty Hamilton Esq. of you the said KER BAILLIE HAMILTON, of Our especial appointed Gograce, certain knowledge and mere motion, have thought foundland and fit to constitute and appoint you, and by these Presents its Dependendo constitute and appoint you, the said KER BAILLIE cies. HAMILTON, to be Our Governor and Commander in Chief in and over Our Island of Newfoundland and the Islands adjacent, and all the Coast of Labrador
