MILLS, JOHN BURFÉ, Q.C. (*Annapolis.*)

• Youngest s. of the late John Mills, Esq., merchant and shipowner, Granville Ferry. Ancestors came from Yorkshire, Eng., and settled in N.S. about 1770. B. at Granville Ferry, 24 July, 1850. Ed. at Acadia Coll., Wolfville, N.S., graduating B.A. with honors in 1871. Received degree of M.A., 1877. M., 23 Oct., 1878, Bessie, second dau. of A. W. Corbitt, Esq. Attended the Law Sch. at Harvard Univ. for one year, and was called to the Bar, N.S., 1875. Apptd. Q.C. by Dom. Govt. 4 Oct. 1890. Was a mem. of the Municipal Council of Annapolis from 1882 to 1887, and is a dir. and office-holder in several local corporations. First returned to Parlt. at last g.e. A Liberal Conservative. Believes in the patriotic policy of Sir John A. Macdonald's Government.—*Annapolis Royal, N.S.*

MONCRIEFF, GEORGE, Q.C. (*East Lambton.*)

S. of W. G. Moncrieff, London, Ont., and grands. of the late Rev. John Moncrieff, Professor of Hebrew, Glasgow, Scot. B., 1842, at Mussellburgh, Scot. Was a pupil in the Southern Academy, Edinburgh, in 1854. Came with his parents to London, Ont., and attended the classes of the late Professor McCauley. M., 1872, at the Tp. of Adelaide, Isabella, eldest. dau. of Thomas Thompson, Esq. Called to the Bar, U.C., 1864. Apptd. Q.C. by Dominion Govt. 14 Dec., 1889. Was Reeve of the village of Petrolia 1867 and 1873, and Mayor of the Town of Petrolia, 1874. First returned to Parlt. at g.e. 1887, and re-elected at last g.e. A Conservative.—*Petrolia, Ont.*

MONET, DOMINIQUE. (*Napierville.*)

S. of Dominique Monet, farmer, of St. Michel d'Napierville. B. there 2 Jan. 1865. Ed. at L'Assomption, Coll. and at Laval Univ. where he graduated LL. B. M. 27 June 1887, Demoiselle Marie Louise LaHaye. Called to the Bar, P.Q., July 1889, and practises in partnership with Mr. T. A. Geoffrion, Montreal. First returned to Parlt. at last g.e.
