

Brunswick, every male subject of the age of 21 years, not disqualified by law, assessed for the year for which the register is made up, in respect of real estate to the amount of \$100, or of personal property, or personal and real, amounting together to \$400, or \$400 annual income. In Nova Scotia, all subjects of the age of 21 years, not disqualified by law, assessed for the year for which the register is made up in respect of real estate to the value of \$150, or in respect of personal estate, or of real and personal together, to the value of \$400.

Voting in Quebec, Ontario, Nova Scotia, Manitoba and British Columbia, is open, on inquiry by the Returning Officers, after the person desirous of voting has by reference to the registration list established his right to vote.

In New Brunswick votes are taken by ballot.

Voting is confined to a single day in all the Provinces, but it is not compulsory that the elections be simultaneous.
