Sheriff may break doors. cases.

IV. And be it enacted, That if the property to be replevined, or any part thereof, be secured or concealed in any dwelling-house or other building or enclosure, and if the Sheriff shall have publicly demanded from the owner and occupant of the premises deliverance thereof, and if 5 the same be not delivered to him within twenty-four hours after such demand made, he may or shall, if necessary, break open such house, building or enclosure for the purpose of replevying such property or any part thereof.
