

or Court of Superior Jurisdiction, within the District where the said road shall be so put out of repair as aforesaid; and upon conviction, the Court before whom the prosecution shall be had, shall direct the said Company to make the necessary repairs, for the want whereof such
 5 prosecution shall have been commenced, within such time as such Court shall seem reasonable; and in default of such repairs being made in the manner and within the time prescribed by such judgment, the said Com-
 10 pany shall be subject to a fine not exceeding four dollars for each offence, which said penalty shall belong to the Municipality.

Penalty in

10 **51.** The said Company shall have power to become a party to prom-
 issory notes and bills of exchange for sums not less than one hundred
 dollars; and any such promissory note made and endorsed, and any
 such bill of exchange drawn, accepted or endorsed by the President of
 the said Company, and countersigned by the Secretary and Treasurer
 15 thereof, under authority of a quorum of the Directors, shall be binding
 upon the said Company; and every such promissory note or bill of ex-
 change, so made, drawn, accepted or endorsed by the President of the
 said Company, and countersigned by the Secretary and Treasurer there-
 of, shall be presumed to have been properly so made, drawn, accepted
 20 or endorsed, as the case may be, unless the contrary be shown; and it
 shall not be necessary to have the seal of the said Company affixed to
 such promissory note or bill of exchange; nor shall the officers of the
 said Company, signing or countersigning the same, or such acceptance
 or endorsement thereof, be thereby subjected individually to any liabili-
 25 ty whatever; Provided always, that nothing herein contained shall be
 held to authorize the said Company to issue any note or bill payable to
 bearer or intended to be circulated as money or as the notes of a Bank.

Proviso.

52. The turnpike gate-keepers shall be special constables, and shall
 be invested with all the powers attached to that office on taking the oath
 30 of office before a Justice of the Peace.

53. The said Company shall only be responsible for the maintenance
 of bridges on the said roads, and not for any damages resulting from
 water courses which shall not have been made by the said Company,
 nor for any accidents that may occur beyond the part of the road
 35 macadamized.

Liability of

54. This Act shall be a Public Act, and shall be judicially taken no-
 tice of as such.
