

Youth Group Lobbying For Ousted Klinck

The Edmonton Young People's Group, of which ousted campus Socred party chairman Wallace Klinck is a member, is agitating for Klinck's readmission to the party.

Klinck was dismissed last week for his distribution of the *Protocols of Zion*, which relates a conspiracy by the Elders of Zion for world conquest.

In a Gateway interview Sunday, Klinck said the young People's Group was to meet Tuesday with Orvis Kennedy, Social Credit League president, to speak on his behalf.

But when Mr. Kennedy was questioned Sunday about the

possibility of Klinck's re-admission, he said:

"Klinck has got to make the first move. I dare not say one way or the other."

He did not mention any meeting with the Young People's Group.

But Owen Anderson, campus Socred leader, said "definitely not" when asked if the party would consider Klinck's re-admission.

"He is definitely at odds with the principles of the Socred League," said Anderson.

Anderson also said it is wrong to call the *Protocols* hate literature.

"What we (the Socreds) say is that the book is a forgery."

Anderson himself says he does not believe the book's history.

"It doesn't make sense to me," he said.

According to Klinck, who

referred to the introduction of the *Protocols*, the book was brought to the Swiss Court by the Federation of Jewish Communities in 1933 in order to test its validity.

"The court proceedings were irregular, and the Swiss Civil Code was set aside," said Klinck in a Gateway interview.

Klinck explained, again with reference to the *Protocols*' introduction, that 16 witnesses on behalf of the plaintiff, but only one for the defence, were called to testify.

In 1935, the court called the *Protocols* "a forgery and demoralizing literature," said Klinck.

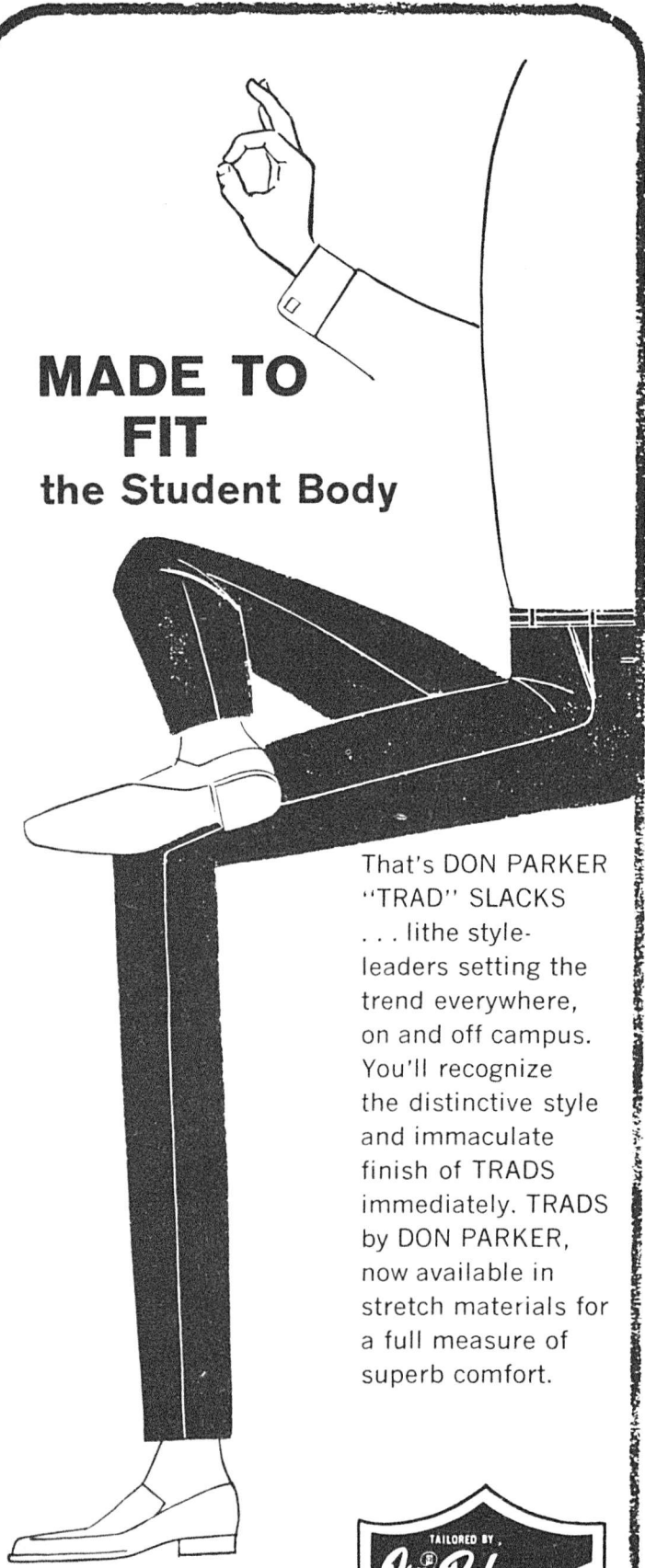
But the Jewish press announced the decision before it was delivered by the court, said Klinck.

In 1937, the Swiss Court of Criminal Appeal quashed the judgment on the *Protocols*.

Orvis Kennedy also calls the *Protocols* a forgery.
