Memorandum for the Deputy Minister.

In reply to your memo hereunder of the 21st Inst. I beg to state that on inquiring at the Lands Branch, it appears that no instructions have been given to Agent Taylor at the Pas to seize the cord-wood which was removed from the 29 acres comprising the Right of Way of the Hudson Bay Company on the Pas Reserve.

Please note in letter to the Chief Engineer of the Railway of the 26th March last hereunder that he was requested to make no entry for construction purposes on the said Right of Way and to cease any operations until the Right of Way had been paid for.
