I have the honor further to state that the Survey held at Quebec on the 2^d December last, was upon the Packages only, which appeared to have been damaged, and the Report does not mention the quantity of the Pieces which are stated as "Not much damaged" were packed & forwarded home by His Excellency's Command. Of these last mentioned Goods it is also said in the Report "that they may be selected sufficiently 'Good' for the purposes intended, if issued immediately." a sufficient time has however elapsed since the date of the above Report of Survey, (provided the Pieces have not been opened) to render the same at present entirely unfit to be sent to Indians.
