years ago with the six Nations at Fort Slavwise; which has stood firm and inviolated to this day.

The mist break was made about mindy sip days after at fort M'Intask, with the half King of the Wyandots Caplain Pipe. and other Chief. in behalf of the Wyandots Delaware Ottowa + Chippawa Nations.

Afterwards Freaties were made with devises Indean Nations south of the River Ohio; and the next breaty was made with Kahaipithaly, here present, and other of & Shawanol chiefs, in behalf of the Shawanol. Nations at the mouth of the Great Mianie which runs into the Ohio.
