

years ago with the six Nations at Fort Maw-wix; which has stood firm and unviolated to this day.

The next treaty was made about ninety six days after, at Fort M'Intosh, with the half King of the Wyandots, Captain Pipe, and other Chiefs, in behalf of the Wyandots Delaware Ottawa & Chippewa Nations.

Afterwards Treaties were made with divers Indian Nations south of the River Ohio; and the next treaty was made with Kakaipithaly, here present, and other & Shawanoel chiefs, in behalf of the Shawanoel Nations, at the mouth of the Great Miami which runs into the Ohio.

Brothers. The Commissioners who conducted these Treaties in behalf of the United States, sent the papers containing them to the Great Council of the States, who supposing them satisfactory
