Sir:-

In answer to your circular letter no. 254017/8. dated 3rd July 1906, I have the honor to report partially on the subjects therein mentioned.

With regard to 3rd section regarding vaccination I regret my present inability to answer the question asked. As you are aware I have only been recently appointed to this office and I could only give data as found in the office records and though I looked very carefully through the diary etc of my predecessors I could find no authentic record of vaccination. However as soon as I make my half yearly visitation to the different villages which will be during the next three months I will find out all that I can from the Indians themselves on this matter and report accordingly.
