
Sir,-

I beg to inform you that the Department has examined the statement of Contractor Sellick for the work done on the Fort Alexander Indian Boarding School, which came to hand some days after your report on the Building.

Mr. Sellick's statement appears to contain in detail all of the extra work done there excepting Davidson's bill for plumbing and heating, etc., which was said to be attached to the statement. Davidson's bill has not yet been before the Department although reference has been made to it and its amount on several occasions, but accompanied by no details.

The account on the whole appears to be reasonable, and providing Davidson's bill is equally so, you should have no difficulty in preparing the final certificate.
