The following telegram has been received by the Soldier Settlement Board:-

"Some Indians from Lemmox Island Reservation have been granted qualification certificates and desire small losms for stock and equipment - Stop - Solicitor states that Reservation is held by Grown as trustee for Indians. Stop. Would we take an agreement for sale of stock, etc., in this case."

For your information I wish to advise you that the Soldier Settlement Act is being administered by this Department in so far as returned Indian soldiers are congerned.

Under separate cover I am sending the necessary forms and instructions, and I shall be glad if you will let me have a full report with regard to the loans desired by the Indians of your Agency.
