Soldier Settlement Board:-


"Some Indians from Lemnox Island Reservation
have been granted qualification certificates
and desire small loans for stock and equip-
ment - Stop - Solicitor states that Reser-
vation is held by Crown as trustee for Indians.
Stop. Would we take an agreement for sale of
stock, etc., in this case."

For your information I wish to advise you that the
Soldier Settlement Act is being administered by this Depart-
ment in so far as returned Indian soldiers are concerned.

Under separate cover I am sending the necessary forms
and instructions, and I shall be glad if you will let me
have a full report with regard to the loans desired by the
Indians of your Agency.

Will you be kind enough to give this matter your
early attention.
