

Alberta - Aberhart has also sought to misrepresent issues to his own advantage, and put Government in difficult position - e. g., measures known to be ultra vires - disallowance;

Ontario - Relations with Ontario Premier have been particularly trying - In spite of greatest provocation, Dominion Government has gone out of its way to co-operate;

Constitutional problems have caused uncertainty;

Constitutional adjustment has failed to keep pace with economic and social change - accumulation, over 70 years, of Constitutional maladjustments has led to misunderstanding and friction between Dominion and provinces;

Government constantly finding its hands tied in seeking needed reform -

e. g., - social legislation; certain provincial authorities have not hesitated to seek political advantage from confusion and uncertainties;
