to them by the same officer, by a special letter suitable to each particular case; and the name of no person shall be entered on the roll of membership until the entrance fee, if any there be payable by such member, has been paid.

ARTICLE IV.

THE ANNUAL DUES OF MEMBERS.

- (1). Each Regular member shall pay annually the sum of two dollars, and each Associate or Junior member shall pay annually the sum of one dollar, dues into the funds of the Society, the same to be payable in advance on the first day of October.
- (2). The payment of entrance fee by members elected after the first of May, and before the first of October, in any year, shall exempt them from payment of the annual dues for the year commencing the first of October following.
- (3). Any member whose dues are in arrears for one year shall not be eligible for office or entitled to vote at any meeting of the Society, and should the dues of any member remain unpaid for two years, after having been duly notified, the Council may at its discretion order the name of such member to be erased from the membership roll of the Society, or may exempt a member from dues when from peculiar circumstances they deem it to be in the interest of the Society so to do.

ARTICLE V.

THE OFFICERS, THEIR QUALIFICATION AND ELECTION.

(1). The officers of the Society shall consist of a President, 1st Vice-President, 2nd Vice-President, Treasurer, Corresponding Secretary, Recording Secretary, Librarian, and Curator; who shall be elected yearly by ballot, at the Annual meeting; a majority of the votes cast by members present and entitled to vote, being sufficient for election.
