

PREFACE.

THE IMPROVED READY RECKONER AND LOG-BOOK contains tables showing the value of any number of pounds, gallons, yards, feet, etc. of any article, from one to a thousand, at from one-quarter of a cent to ten dollars each, so arranged that a person may, by looking at the head of the page to find the given price, and at the column on the side for the number wanted, see at a glance the amount of value required. As an example, suppose you wish to know what 35 pounds of tea would cost at 49 cents per po. l. By referring to page 71 and following the left-hand column until you reach 35, opposite this number you will find \$17.15, the amount required.

It also contains carefully-prepared Tables of Board, Scantling, Plank, and Log Measures, as well as methods for calculating the measuremer of Stonework and Masonry; Tables of Weights
