PRAYERS

RESOLVED, That William M. Howe, Esq., be appointed additional Reporter to this House.

Mr. *Beer* moved that the Standing Rule adopted by the House, last Session, viz: "That the Speaker do take the Chair, punctually, every morning, at ten o'clock, and that this House, at its evening sitting, do rise, punctually, at six o'clock," be suspended.
