

X. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That from and out of the said rates and duties, there be granted to His said Majesty, His Heirs and Successors, a sufficient sum annually to enable His Majesty to pay to the Judges of Assize and Nisi Prius, Oyer and Terminer and General Gaol Delivery, the sum of Twenty-five Pounds for each time that they shall hold any such Court or Courts in any District of this Province, except the Home District, for the purpose of defraying their travelling expenses; and also a sum sufficient to enable His Majesty to pay the Clerks of Assize their usual and accustomed Fees, for the duties performed by them as Officers of the Courts of Oyer and Terminer, and General Gaol Delivery; and also to pay the Sheriff of the Home District, the sum of Eleven Shillings and eight pence per day, for attending the Terms of the Court of King's Bench at the Seat of Government.

Judges travelling expenses allowed at the rate of £25 for each District, except the Home District.

Fees of Clerks of Assize.

## CHAP. II.

*AN ACT to Establish a Court of Chancery in this Province.*

[Passed 4th March, 1837.]

**F**OR the more perfect Administration of Justice in this Province: *Be it enacted* by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Upper Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, entitled "An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act passed in the fourteenth year of His Majesty's reign, entitled 'An Act for making more effectual provision for the Government of the Province of Quebec in North America, and to make further provision for the Government of the said Province,'" and by the authority of the same, That there be constituted and established, and there is hereby constituted and established a Court of Chancery, to be called and known by the name and style of "The Court of Chancery for the Province of Upper Canada," of which Court, the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, or Person Administering the Government of this Province, shall be Chancellor. And that for the better administration of Justice in the said Court, the Judicial powers thereof, both legal and equitable, shall be exercised by a Judge, to be appointed by His Majesty under the Great Seal of the Province, and to be called and known as "the Vice Chancellor of Upper Canada;" and who shall hold his Office during good behaviour; which said Court shall be holden at the Seat of Government in the said Province, or in such other place as shall be ap-
