- Do you use safety matches?

- Are ashes deposited in METAL receptacles and removed from the building weekly?
- Is there any unenclosed space under the house where inflammable trash may accumulate?
- Are chimneys built on the ground, or on brackets? Are they in good repair? Have flues been cleaned for winter?
- Are stovepipes passing through partitions properly protected? Do stovepipes pass through attics, closets, or unused rooms where they may come in contact with anything combustible?
- Is the use of gasoline forbidden inside the house?
- Have you any fire extinguishers? Do all members of the family understand their operation?
- Do you know where the nearest fire alarm box is? The telephone number of the Fire Department?
