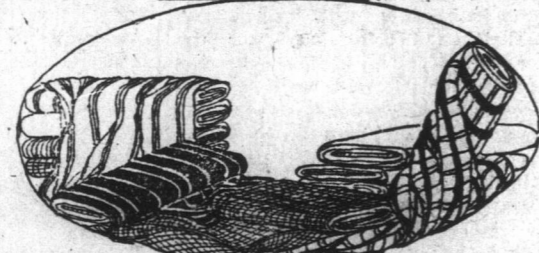

**Freight by Air.**

England is credited with being the foremost nation in aviation. In fifteen months, the record shows 22,000 passengers and 200,000 pounds of freight travelled 1,000,000 miles in 45,000 flights. The trans-Atlantic passenger schedule, which was so confidently predicted as almost nonexistent several years ago, is still remote, but it is a long way off, in spite of the fact that a round trip from London to Paris (574 miles) can be made in six hours instead of twenty-four, at a cost of about \$90 for plane, against \$40 by rail. The aero company which is operating a passenger service between Key West and Havana charges \$150 for one passenger one way from New York to Boston (1,000 miles).
