Who's Who?

Ladies and Gentlemen MR. CHARLES BERTON Musical Director. Mr. Berton was born in Yorkshire England. He has had an eventful life and as a result of his work occupies a foremost place in his profession. He has been assistant director, director, conductor, composer, and author, all in turn. The record of his achievements is a lengthy one. Here are some of them compressed: Worked with Sir Edgar Allan the foremost living music composer; worked with Dr. Richter, Wagner's amanuensis; worked with John Coates the famous English tenor; was assistant musical director for Gilbert and Sullivan when producing their operas throughout England; was organist of Bradford Church, Yorkshire, for 15 years; acted as conductor of the Bradford Choral Society for 5 years. Met Jesse Laska, the American producer, in London and wrote for him a vaudeville act 'The Stunning Grenadier' which was produced at the Oxford Theatre; went to New York and wrote all Laska's vaudeville acts, amongst them 'The Love Waltz, The Welford, The Twentieth Century, The Eight Hoboes.' Wrote all the music for the Folies Bergere, the new theatre built by Laska; toured the U.S.A. with Lina Abarbanell in the 'Mikado'; wrote two operas and has just finished a play 'Dolly' to be produced by the Schuberts shortly; has written hundreds of sacred tunes which are still used in the churches in the north of England; knows over 150 operas, musical comedies and oratorios. And he walks around like an ordinary human being. But genius ever seeks seclusion. Mr. Berton, whom all will now regard with intense interest, will be glad to make your better acquaintance at the Casino.
