FOOTBALL SEASON OPENS.
Game Ends In Draw.
Before a large attendance of spectators the opening football match for the season was played at St. George's Field last evening between the B.I.S. and Saints eleven, and saw the game end in a scoreless draw. The brand of football doled out was a very disappointing one, both teams lacking in practice, and many were the chances lost by erratic shooting in front of goal.

The Saints winning the toss decided to play from the western goal, with their opponents handicapped by the strong sun. From the kick-off play was confined to mid-field, with much throwing-in play in evidence. The Irishmen then took control, and working the ball west, made an unsuccessful attack on goal, the ball was skied high over the bar. Play for the next few minutes was of a give and take nature, with very little football witnessed by either side. The B.I.S. forwards kept pressing into their opponent's territory, until they earned for themselves a corner, it was nicely placed but successfully cleared. The goalies in the first half had very little to do, the lines being well defended.

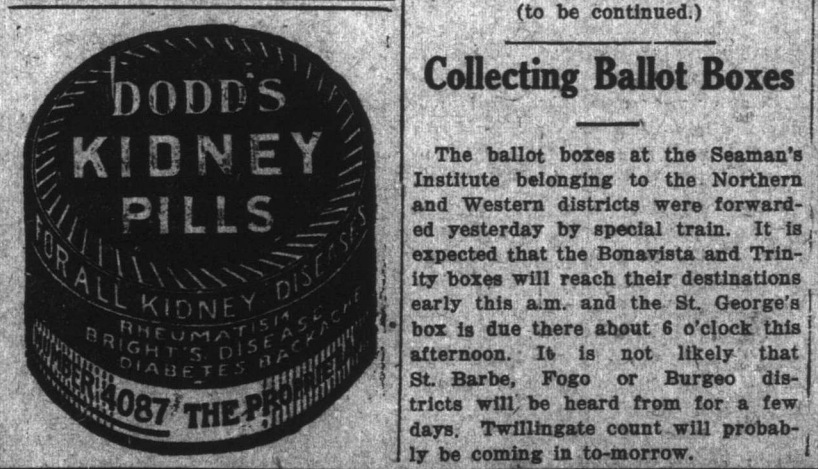
In the second half the play improved somewhat, with the Irishmen figuring in the attack. Time and again the Phelan boys worked the leather through, only to fall down in front of the defence. After ten minutes of play the Saints made a determined attack on goal and all but scored. Ryan, the B.I.S. goalie handled a rather difficult shot and just managed to clear in time. Many of the spectators were of the opinion that the ball had gone over the line, but the referee thought otherwise. Play was very exciting for the next few minutes; the B.I.S. players renewed their efforts and invaded the Scotch territory. Three corners followed in quick succession, but no scoring resulted. The B.I.S. players kept pressing matters almost constantly, but the shooting of the forwards was away of the mark. During the dying moments of the game Belbin saved a hard shot from Phelan.
