CHILDREN'S BRANCH FOR PUBLIC LIBRARY

Board Will Call for Tenders for the
Work.

A special committee of the Public
Library board was instructed at a
meeting last evening to call for ten-
ders for the establishment of a child-
ren's branch, and it is probable that
the work will be proceeded with within
a short time, at an estimated outlay
of slightly over \$200.

The children's room will be located
where the ladies' room is at present
located. The ladies will then be ac-
commodated in the reference depart-
ment, which at present affords ample
space for all purposes.

The portable school libraries are also
now established, and when the scheme
is fully worked out over \$400 worth of
equipment will have been furnished
for the students of the public and sepa-
rate school libraries. The Public Librarian W. O.
Carson has been at work on the scheme
for several months and has accumulated
much valuable data.

The board has decided to issue bor-
rowers' cards to students of city
schools whose homes are not within the
municipality. These cards may be used,
however, only during the months of
the school year.

Other routine business was also look-
ed after at last night's meeting.

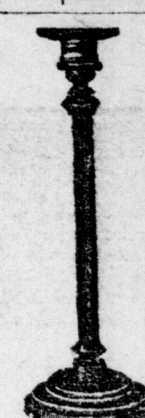

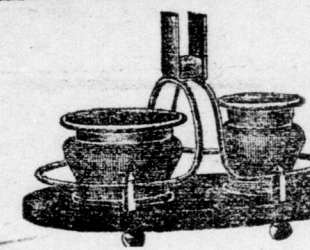

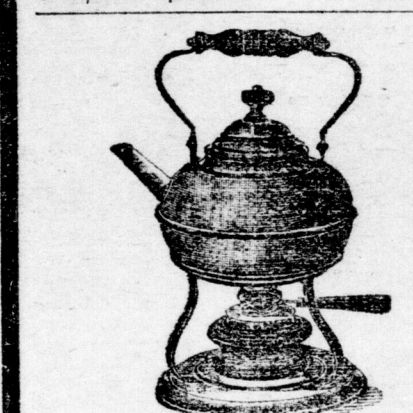

EAST LONDON NEWS

MR. WILLIAM HAYMAN WILL BE CANDIDATE

East End Progressives Will Place Him
in Nomination.

Mr. Wm. Hayman has consented to
become the municipal candidate for
the city council to represent the East
London Progressives. After accepting,
Mr. Hayman made the statement that
he would not canvas for a single vote
in the campaign, but if he was elected
he would devote all his time to mu-
nicipal interests. His friends in the
association promised to "plump" for
him, and work for his election.

Much criticism was handed to Parks
Commissioner Dillger for alleged mis-
takes made by him, and in his depart-
ment in fixing up and laying out new

walks, etc. The dismissal of ex-Parks
Commissioner Fring, they deemed en-
tirely unwarranted, he having had no
opportunity to show his ability.

The question of electrification was
again introduced, but only one or two
ventured to express an opinion on the
matter. The members evidently feared
to place themselves on record for or
against a project about which so little
is known.

Messrs. Fring and Bulgar were ap-
pointed a committee to inspect the in-
cinerator now being built, and which
is alleged to be in a poor condition.
The committee will report at the next
meeting of the Progressives.
