YORK COUNTY COUNCIL. The Business of the Session Concluded Saturday.

The first business transacted at Saturday's meeting of the York County Council was the consideration of Mr. Lomas' motion providing for the establishing of a lockup and the appointment of a constable at Coleman.

Mr. Lomas vigorously supported his resolution and pointed out the necessity of more protection. The matter was finally laid over until the January session.

The Committee on Roads and Bridges recommended the payment of \$100 to meet the grant made by Peel County, which was asked for by the reeves and deputy reeves of King. The report was adopted.

Regarding the communication from the City Solicitor respecting the assignment of the agreement with the Mimico Electric Railway Company, the committee was of opinion that the city should have the right to compel the railway company to keep their tracks in an efficient state of repair, still that an assignment of the agreement may give the city power that they may impose such conditions on the railway company.

Saturday Evening, Nov. 24. The feeling in Wall-street has improved some stocks and closed strong.

Cable and Canadian Pacific were firmer to-day.

Consols firmer, closing at 108 5/16 for money and account.

Canadian Pacific is 1-8 better, closing in London to-day at 60 3/8. St. Paul is closed at 60 1/2. Erie at 18 7/8 and N.Y.C. at 101 1/2.

Exports of wheat, and flour as wheat, both costs, United States and Canada, amount this week to 3,812,000 bushels, as compared with 2,909,000 bushels last week.

The visible supply of wheat on Monday is expected to show an increase of 1,600,000 bushels. During the corresponding week of last year the increase was 650,000 bushels.

The earnings of C.P.R. for the week ended Nov. 21 are \$460,000, a decrease of \$39,000.
