cured a doctor and a stone-mason, went back to the house with them, and desired the latter to remove the stone step at the foot of the cellar stairs.

He did so, and they discovered underneath it some bones which the doctor, after a hasty examination, pronounced to be those of a woman. They also detected a quantity of quick lime, which had evidently been placed there for the purpose of destroying the skeleton. Mrs. Merrit collected the remains, gave them Christian burial, and was never again troubled by the "Calico woman."

Some time afterward Mrs. Merrit learnt that in former years the old mansion had been an abode of snugglers, who were known to have a woman—a sort of "Ruth," in fact—among their number.

When they departed she mysteriously disappeared, and it was never

exactly known what had become of her.

You may reply 22 18 was white's best move. But is that a sufficient answer? Suppose the white does not choose to make his best move-what becomes of the solution ? Again, seeing that it does not enable him to draw—how could you justify him in giving away the piece? I can understand how 22 18 might be given as a possible variation. But should it be given as the trank move of the solution? In other words is any solution sound which does not rest on forced moves? 
