

11. *Communication with the Entities.* Communication between the Board and the entities of the two countries will be through the offices of the respective Chairmen.

12. *Rules and Regulations.* The Board is empowered to make only such supplementary rules and regulations as are consistent with the procedures defined herein in order to carry out its duties and responsibilities as set forth in the Treaty.

13. *Composition of the Board.* The Board shall consist of five members, two from each of the two countries and one from the United States of America. The members shall be appointed by the respective Governments of the two countries and the United States of America for a term of five years.

14. *Chairman and Vice-Chairman.* The Board shall elect a Chairman and a Vice-Chairman from among its members. The Chairman shall preside at all meetings of the Board and shall be the chief executive officer of the Board. The Vice-Chairman shall act in the absence of the Chairman.

15. *Meetings.* The Board shall meet at least once a year. The Board may also meet at such other times as may be deemed necessary by a majority of its members. The Board shall hold its meetings in such place as it may determine.

16. *Reports.* The Board shall submit an annual report to the United States of America and the other country. The report shall contain a statement of the Board's activities during the year and a statement of the Board's financial condition. The Board shall also submit such other reports as may be required by the United States of America and the other country.

17. *Expenses.* The Board shall be reimbursed for its expenses by the United States of America and the other country. The Board shall also be reimbursed for the expenses of its members.

18. *Amendment of the Treaty.* This Treaty may be amended by a majority of the members of the Board. Any amendment shall be subject to the approval of the United States of America and the other country.

19. *Final Provisions.* This Treaty shall enter into force on the day of its ratification by the United States of America and the other country. This Treaty shall remain in force until it is terminated by a majority of the members of the Board.

20. *Signature.* This Treaty shall be signed by the Chairman of the Board and the representatives of the United States of America and the other country.
