Article VIII

The Parties shall permit the temporary entry, exempt from tax and duty, of materials required for the application of this Agreement, in accordance with the laws and regulations in force in each State.

Article IX

- 1. A Joint Committee shall be created to present to the competent authorities of each Party recommendations concerning the development of the co-operation and exchanges which are the subject of this Agreement and the means of solving difficulties which arise from its application.
- 2. The Joint Committee shall meet once every two years alternately in each State. In the interval, it may meet as required.
- 3. Each Party shall appoint its representatives to sit on the Joint Committee.
- 4. In accordance with the Cultural Agreement of November 17, 1965, the joint Canadian and French Commission shall study at its meetings the programmes of action presented by the Joint Committee.

Article X

Each Party shall notify the other of the completion of the formalities required by its Constitution for the entry into force of the present Agreement. The Agreement shall come into force on the first day of the second month following the date of receipt of the second of these notifications.
