

GUIDE TO THE USER

The index headings are arranged alphabetically, but some are headed by dates in order that they may be found on the following page.

The index provides general subject matter as well as subject headings under the names of Members of Parliament indicating those matters discussed by them. The numbers immediately following the entries refer to the appropriate pages in the index also provided.

All subject entries in the index are arranged alphabetically, unless otherwise indicated.

A typical entry may consist of a main heading followed by one or more sub-headings.

Conventions to a first sub-heading are denoted by a key dash.

The most common abbreviations which could be found in the index are as follows:

M. J. P. = first, second, third reading; A = Appendix; S. = Statement; C. = Question; G. = Government response; M. = Motion; Q. = Question; C. = Question on the Order Paper; R.A. = Royal Assent; R. = Return entered; M.C. = Member of Canada; S.O. = Standing Order
