of restriction, the restriction of the markets of the farmers. They have remained in power upon a policy of restriction, the restriction of the proper development of Canada as a nation within the Empire. Elected upon restriction of trade, remaining to restrict the development of Canada, they propose to establish both policies by the restriction of free speech. We stand for freedom on every count of the indictment; and we have not the shadow of a shade of doubt that the people of Canada stand with us.
