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katchewan, a federal contribution, putting 1,000 young people to work accomplishing those tasks would surely be a good use of money. I think the government should have spent money on that, but as is so often the case everybody said it was a good idea but bureaucratically impossible.

We have to use this department. We have to give it enough authority to make sure that we can shake some of those bureaucratic trees so that what actually makes sense actually gets done.
