

# INTRODUCTION.

This List is the first continuation of the LIST OF DISPLACED GERMAN SCHOLARS published in 1936. It contains the names of University teachers and research workers, i.e. Professors ("ordentliche" and "ausserordentliche"), Privatdozenten (Lecturers), Assistants and Researchers who have lost their positions in Germany for political or racial reasons since autumn, 1936. The List is intended only for the internal use of Universities and Government Educational Authorities. The publication has been made possible by the Rockefeller Foundation in New York.

There are still several hundreds of dismissed German scholars of merit who are without work or in inadequate positions. Many others have lost their new positions, for instance in Spain, Russia and China. There are over 150 new names of dismissed scholars on our records since the last List was issued.

Printed publications, such as University Year Books, and personal information form the basis of this List. It was not possible to ask the persons mentioned for permission to publish their names.
