With reference to my memorandum numbered 1, the only alterations that are necessary would be to change the date, at the bottom of page 2, to the 30th. of June 1920, and on page 3, first line, Provincial Estimates for 1920-21. The amounts voted by the Legislature have remained at the same figure since 1916. 2. In memorandum numbered 2, concerning Macdonald College School for Teachers, the following may be added under"Public Accounts 1919-20,"the last issued :-Normal School Grant \$185,000.00 2,005.83 Repairs Laval Normal Water Supply, Laval Normal 424.00 Repairs and Maintenance 5,000.00 of Normal Schools Pedagogical lectures 9,500.00 \$201,929.83 The other figures that I have mentioned in connection with the comparison of diplomas granted cannot be given for more recent years, because they are no longer printed in the report of the Superintendent of Public Instruction. If you are satisfied with the corrections that I have made in memorandum numbered 1, and with the presentation of the case, I shall be glad to have sufficient copies mimeographed, in order to place one copy in the hands of each member of the Board of Governors.
