

töt, num. adj. indecl. *So many.*
 töt-Idem, num. adj. indecl. [tot, "so many"] *Just so many or as many.*

töt-les, num. adv. [id.] *So many times, so often.*

töt-tus, ta, tum (Gen. tötlus; Dat. tötl), adj., hence, *The whole or entire; the whole of* [akin to root TU, in meaning of "to increase"].

träb-s, is, f. *A beam* [akin to *πάνηξ*].

träho, traxi, tractum, trähöre, 3. v. a.: *To drag away or along. To drag or pull along gently. To draw forth.*

trä-jäcio, jöcl, jectum, jööre, 3. v. a. [for tra-jäcio; fr. tra (=trans), "through"; jäcio, "to cast"] *To pierce.*

trans-éo, ivi or ii, itum, ire, v. a. irreg. [trans, "beyond"; eo, "to go"] *Of time: To pass by, elapse.*

trans-féro, tüli, lätum, ferre, v. a. [trans, "across"; féro, "to carry"] *To transfer.*

trans-figo, fixi, fixum, figere, 3. v. a. [trans, "through"; figo, "to fix," "to fix by piercing, pierce"] *To pierce through, transfix.*

tre-mo, mti, no sup., mère, 3. v. n. *To tremble, quiver.* etc. [akin to Gr. *τρέω*].

tres, tria, num. adj. plur. *Three* [Gr. *τρεις*].

tridens, ntis, masc. [tridens, "having three teeth or tines"] *A three-tined spear; a trident.*

tri-ginta, num. adj. plur. indecl. [tres, tri-a, "three"; gintia = *κοντα* = "ten"] ("Three tens"; i.e.) *Thirty.*

tris-tis, te, adj.: *Sad, sorrowful.* Comp.: *Very sad or sorrowful.* Comp. trist-ior; (Sup. trist-issimus) [prob. akin to root TRAS, "to tremble"; and so, literally, "trembling"].

tü, tü (plur. vos, vestrum or vestri), pron. pers. *Thou, you* [av, Doric form *vv*].

tü-śor, itus sum, śri, 2. v. dep.: *To look, behold. To protect, defend.*

tum, adv.: *At that time; then. In a series: Then, in the next place* [prob. akin to a demonstr. root TO; Gr. *τό*].

tüm-idus, ida, idum, adj. [tüm-ō, "to swell"] *Swelling, swollen.*

tu(n)do, tütidi, tupsum and tüsüm, tundëre, 3. v. a. *To strike, beat, smite* [akin to root TUD, "to strike"].

turba, ae, f. *A crowd, multitude, throng* [Gr. *τύρβη*].

turb-o, avi, åtum, åre, 1. v. a. [turb-a] *To disturb, agitate, confuse. To throw into disorder or confusion.*

turb-o, inis, m. [1. turb-o, "to move violently"] *A whirlwind, hurricane.*

tü-s, ris, n. *Incense, frankincense* [öv-ös, öv-eiv, "to sacrifice"].

tü-tus, ta, tum, adj. [tü-śor, "to protect"] *Safe, in safety.*

tü-us, a, um, pron. poss. [tü, tü-i] *Thy, thine; your.* —As Subst.: tü, örüm, m. plur.: *Thy, or your, friends or followers.*

týrannus, i, m.: Originally: *A monarch, sovereign, who obtained supreme power contrary to the institutions of his country; opposed to βασιλεύς, an hereditary possessor of royalty. A despot, tyrant* [rýpar-vos].

über, éris, n. ("A teat," etc.; hence) *Fertility, fruitfulness, richness* [akin to Gr. *οὐθαρ*; cf. Eng. "udder"].

ü-bi, adv. [akin to qu-i] *Of time: When; as soon as. Of place: Where.*

übi-que, adv. [übi, no. 2; que, indef. suffix] *Wherever it may be; anywhere, everywhere.*

ul-lus, la, lum (Gen. ullius; Dat. ullii), adj. [for un-lus; fr. ün-us, "one"] *Any* :—non ullius, *not any, none, no.* —As Subst. m. *Any man, any one.*

umbra, ae, f. *Shade, shadow. The shade, spirit, or ghost of a departed person.*

umeet-o, åre, åvi, åtum, 1. v. n. *To moisten, wet, bedew* [connected üvv, sudor, sudus].

umer-us, i, m. [akin to *ώμος*, "a shoulder"] *The shoulder.*

ün-å, adv. [adverbial abl. of ün-us, "one"] *At one and the same time, together.*
