

SEC. 7.—The Lady Visitors shall dispose for Temperance purposes, of all funds (raised by themselves) in such manner as shall be decided upon by a majority of Visitors present at any meeting of which notice has been given by the W. P. in open Division at least one week previously. They shall choose at each meeting one of their number present to preside.

SEC. 8.—Any Visitor charged with violation of the pledge, or other improper conduct shall be made officially acquainted with such charge, when if she requests it, a Committee consisting of three members and two visitors shall be appointed to try the matter in the usual manner—otherwise her name shall be erased upon the order of a two-third vote of the Division.

SEC. 9.—Any Lady Visitor found guilty of having violated her pledge, and who may wish to be re-admitted, shall after the usual ballot, if in the affirmative, be re-obligated in the ante-room by the W. P. and Lady Conductor.
