*At the Epistle, say,*

**M**AYEST thou, O Lord, be eternally praised for having communicated thy divine Spirit to the holy prophets and apostles, disclosing to them admirable secrets, redounding to thy glory and our salvation. We firmly believe their doctrine, because it is thine. Grant us, we beseech thee, the happiness to understand from the Church, through their instructions, what is profitable for us, and grace to practise the same to the end of our lives.

*At the Gradual, say,*

**H**OW wonderful, O Lord, is thy name throughout the whole earth! I will bless the Lord at all times; his praise shall be ever in my mouth. Be thou my God and my protector: in thee alone will I put my trust, O let me not be confounded for ever.
