PSALM LI.

HAVE mercy upon me, O God, after
 thy great goodness : according to the
 multitude of thy mercies do away mine
 offences.

Wash me thoroughly from my wicked-
 ness : and cleanse me from my sin.

For I acknowledge my faults : and my
 sin is ever before me.

Against Thee only have I sinned, and
 done this evil in Thy sight : that Thou
 mightest be justified in Thy saying, and
 clear when Thou art judged.
