Baseball and cricket were out of the question. There were a few games of soccer, and part of the big golf match between Lambton and Toronto was completed. You cannot stop lacrosse, and Toronto and the Irish-Canadians gave a good exhibition under the circumstances at the Beach. Added to the rain was a hurricane, and this affected the half-holiday water sports, that were only partially carried out.

The Leafs may take new life and set back into the stride they displayed in the month now that Harry Bemis is back in uniform. They started well on the trip abroad, that will last thru the east end of the circuit and ends with the return of the boys to meet Rochester at the Island on Dominion Day. Here's hoping that they will then be in first place!

The Washington Senators, who are winning game after game in their mad dash thru the west, are now only four games behind the major league record of consecutive victories, held at twenty, by the Providence team, which is a member of the National League in 1912. The American League record is held by the Chicago White Sox, which won twenty consecutive games from May 23 to June 23, 1912.

The fair grounds, Kinloch Park and Delmar Park in St. Louis were put out of business by former Governor Joseph Folk, who Edward Gorman carried into Kansas City. Corrigans went broke when the reformers killed racing in New Orleans. The fair grounds, which were invested in City Park, which ran in opposition to the fair grounds, tracks at Jacksonville, Tampa and Pensacola were closed by Florida legislators last year, while Caroline put the bee on Columbia and Charleston last winter.

Two finely appointed tracks in Hot Springs, Ark., called up the shutters several years ago. John Condon, the blind Chicago sportsman, who owned the Oaklawn Park venture, in California, Emeryville, Ingleside, Tanforan and Santa Anita are going to wreck and ruin. Long ago the game was smothered at Roby, Ind., and Alexander Island, Va. Texas got in line by prohibiting racing and bookmaking at San Antonio and Dallas. Van Hill gave up the ghost before Maryland even thought of legalizing the sport of kings.

It looks like Toronto and the Nationals to fight it out for the championship of the Big Four with the Boston Red Sox, the top in the N.L.U. and now New Westminster wins at Vancouver, being away from home this year.

Johnny Kilbane's featherweight championship of the world, will receive \$4000 for minutes of fighting when he takes on Johnny Dundee in a ten-round bout in New York to-morrow night.
