CONFERENCE ON DELIVERY OF GERMAN MUNITIONS

Paris, April 13.—Winston Spencer Churchill and André Lefevre, respectively, the British and French war ministers conferred yesterday with regard to technical means of applying the stipulations of the treaty of Versailles concerning the delivery and destruction of German munitions and war material, especially artillery. Marshal Foch, General Maxime Weygand, assistant to the marshal, Major-General Buat, French chief of staff, and Major-General Sackville-West were present.

A complete agreement was reached at the conference, it was announced. It was decided, among other things, that the number of British and French officers engaged in this work by the interallied central commission must be increased.
