I have the honor to present a report of the proceedings of the Governors for the year which ended 30th April, 1880.

The "Ordinary" Expenditure of the year has been.. \$32,816 71

Little or no "Extra" Expenditure was incurred during the year.

That of the present year is less than that of last by \$870 38

The "Ordinary" Income of the year has exceeded that of 1878-79 by \$4,440.14.
