Death of Rev. W. A. Lang.-The death, recently, of Rev. W. A. Lang, a member of this Committee, was reported, and it was agreed to express sympathy with Mrs. Lang in her bereavement.

Rev. A. Findlay's Travelling Expenses.-Dr. Laing, Messrs. Moodie and Mackenzie were appointed a sub-committee to consider the question of the travelling expenses of the Rev. Allan Findlay in supervising the mission field under his care. At a later stage the subcommittee presented a report, recommending that hereafter, in addition to his salary of $\$ \mathrm{t} 200$ per annum, Mr. Findlay be allowed a mileage rate of four cents per mile on all his travelling, whether in Muskoka, Parry Sound, Nipissing or Algoma districts. The report was received and its recommendation adopted.

Winter Supply.-With a view to comply with the requirements of last General Assembly regarding the winter supply of mission fields, the Secretary was instructed to prepare a suitable schedule, to be sent to the conveners of the several Presbyteries of the Church..
