HOW THE ART STUDENT LIVES WHILE IN PARIS

F. H. C. Miles Delivers an Interesting Lecture Before the St. John Art Club

Fred H. C. Miles delivered an interesting lecture before the St. John Art Club last evening on student life in Paris. Mr. Miles studied under the great Julian and the lecture consisted mainly of recollections of the life of the studio and the people who frequent there. A large audience followed the lecture closely and with evident appreciation.

A number of excellent paintings by John C. Miles were hung on the walls of the studio and attracted much attention. They included landscapes in St. John and surrounding counties and sketches in water color for future paintings. There were
