CONDITIONS OF ADMISSION.

1st.—That all Travelling Expenses to and from  
Towns are to be paid either by the Patients  
or those sending them.

2nd.—That Three Dollars per Week are to be  
paid by each Patient, or those sending them,  
towards expenses of Board, Washing, and  
Lodging, while at the Infirmary.

3rd.—That Apprentices or others sending Pa-  
tients to the Infirmary, are required to guar-  
antee Fifteen Dollars (the price of five  
Weeks Board); and should the Patient leave  
the Infirmary before the five weeks are expired,  
a proportionate sum will be returned.

4th.—No charge for Medical Treatment, and  
Medicines; and Patients are at liberty to board  
away from the Infirmary if they prefer it.

Infirmary open to the Poor every Morning at Nine  
o'clock, Sundays excepted.
