BRITISH AND RUSSIAN ON WESTERN FRONT

Washington, July 18—British armored
motor detachments are talking part in
the Russian offensive in Galicia, accord-
ing to semi-official information received
today from Petrograd by the Russian
embassy here.
This is the first mention of the presence
of British forces in Russia and says
the armored cars are co-operating effec-
tively with Belgian detachments, sent
there soon after the war began.
