

SIXTEENTH ANNUAL SESSION
OF THE
SYNOD OF THE DIOCESE OF MONTREAL.

FIRST DAY.

The Sixteenth Annual Meeting of the Synod of Montreal was held on Tuesday, the 15th June, 1875.

Divine Service was celebrated in the Cathedral.

Morning Prayer was said by Rev. Canon Bancroft, D.D., and Rev. Canon Ellegood, M.A.; the Lessons were read by Rev. Canon Evans, M.A., the Ante-Communion service by the Most Reverend the Metropolitan and the Rector. The sermon was preached by Rev. James Carmichael, M.A.; and Holy Communion was administered by the Very Rev. the Dean, LL.D., Ven. Archdeacon Leach, D.C.L., LL.D., Ven. Archdeacon Lonsdell, M.A., and Rev. Canon Bancroft, D.D., LL.D.

The Synod assembled in the Synod Hall, at two o'clock, for business.

The Bishop opened the meeting with prayer, after which the roll of the Clerical members was called by the Clerical Secretary; and the roll of the Lay members by the Lay Secretary.

It was moved and seconded:

That Rev. J. Empson be re-elected Clerical Secretary:—*Carried.*

It was moved and seconded:

That Mr. Pangman be the Lay-Secretary.

It was moved in amendment:

That Mr. F. Mackenzie be re-elected Lay Secretary.—*Carried.*
